GREENWAY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGIES EXECUTIVE TESTIFIES BEFORE CONGRESS

October 17, 2007, Carrollton, Ga. – Greenway Medical Technologies Inc. further established itself as a leader in the healthcare information technology (HIT) industry with its latest testimony before the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Science and Technology. The Committee is responsible for overseeing research and development programs for several federal agencies including the Department of Energy, Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Homeland Security and the National Institute of Standards and Technology.

The testimony, presented by Greenway's vice president of marketing and governmental affairs, Justin Barnes, focused on the progress of HIT adoption as well as the investments in technology and standards development necessary to create a national system of secure, interoperable healthcare information technology. This testimony marks the seventh time Greenway has testified or spoken on a panel before Congress in the last two years.

This Briefing provided guidance for the House Ways & Means Committee as they contemplate introducing an HIT bill in the 2nd session of the 110th Congress (9/24/07).
- HIT industry's first Presidential HIT Panel at the National Press Club in DC for all Health Policy Advisors of Presidential candidates. Campaigns represented on this panel included Governor Mitt Romney, Senator John McCain, Senator Hillary Clinton, Senator Barrack Obama and Senator Christopher Dodd. This panel discussion

helped emphasize the importance of HIT legislation and demonstrated how leading candidates are shaping their platforms to address the growing issue (9/25/07).

- Testimony before the U.S. House of Representative’s Committee on Science and Technology regarding the topic of “Meeting the Need for Interoperability and Information Security in Healthcare IT” (9/26/07).
